The large entrance hall contains a handmade feature timber staircase and leads you to 3 large bedrooms and a master suite with en-suite bathroom and walk in wardrobes. On the ground floor the heart of the home is the large handmade kitchen with cooking range and breakfast bar which connects seamlessly to the dining area. The separate large homely living room is large enough for the frequent family gatherings yet still retains a cosy warm feeling.
