Constructed over a 14 month period by AM Griffiths & Son, the project comprised of the refurbishment, extension and alteration of the existing Godfrey Brown Theatre to form a new performing arts centre in the grounds of the Grade II listed Royal Grammar School in Worcester.

Completed in December 2018, the finished building includes new entrances & a foyer; new dressing rooms & a 'Green Room'; new visitors toilets; and a refurbished auditorium & drama studios. New heating, ventilation and lighting systems were installed throughout.

The project has been nominated for a **National Brick Award** by Istock Bricks.
